DRESS CODE

At Townsville Central State School, through a process of consultation and discussion, we have developed a student dress code consisting of an agreed standard of presentation and items of clothing which our students are expected to wear, when:

- Attending or representing our school
- Travelling to and from school
- Engaging in school activities outside of school hours

Townsville Central State School is a uniform school and we promote the wearing of our uniform with pride. Uniforms create and reinforce identity, foster a sense of belonging, help develop positive self-esteem and an awareness of appropriate dress code standards.

The Student Dress Code reflects school community standards and is consistent with occupational health and safety and anti-discrimination legislation. We are also a Sun Smart school and our code reflects the school's Sun Safe policy.

Uniform

Shirt: Polo shirt ***Prep to Year 5**
Red polo shirt with black insert & school logo



Shirt: Polo shirt ***Year 6 students**
Black polo shirt with red insert & school logo



Shorts: Black shorts

Skirt: Black box pleat skirt or skirt of an appropriate length

Shoes: Closed in shoes.
May be formal school shoes or runners

Hat: Red broad-brimmed hat or bucket hat
Hats should be worn at all times when in the sun. **No student will be allowed to play** outside or participate in an outdoor activity without a hat.

Winter Uniform

During the colder weather, the following options are permitted:

- Red school jacket with logo
- Plain red or black jacket, jumper or cardigan
- Plain black trousers or tracksuit pants

Jewellery

- One pair of sleepers or studs
- Wrist watch

Any other items of jewellery must be of religious, medical, cultural or long term personal significance.

Other Requirements

- Hair of shoulder length or longer should be tied back
- Make-up and nail polish is not to be worn to school
- Facial and/or body piercings are not acceptable and will need to be removed daily

Expectations of Student Presentation

The Townsville Central State School Student Dress Code identifies three categories;

- accepted school uniform,
- reasonable dress and
- inappropriate dress.

It takes into consideration all aspects of student presentation including clothing, headwear, footwear and other aspects of personal presentation.

Non-uniform Days

Throughout the year, non-uniform days may be held for various reasons and it is expected that students dress appropriately on those occasions.

Reasonable / Appropriate Dress includes:

- Sleeved shirt (shoulders covered)
- Shorts / Skirts of an appropriate length
- Broad-brimmed or bucket hat
- Closed in shoes
- Jewellery – as per usual uniform day

All clothing items should be clean and tidy, maintain personal modesty and comply with our Sun Safe policy.

Inappropriate Dress includes:

- Clothing that has offensive or suggestive messages
- Singlets, midriffs, open sandals and thongs
- Items likely to disrupt or negatively influence normal school operations
- Items unsafe for student or others
- Items likely to result in a risk to health and safety of student or others

In the event of a student wearing inappropriate clothing it may be necessary to contact parents to identify more immediate action to be taken i.e. students may be required to access the second hand uniform collection, or if their presentation is interfering with their own or other's ability to effectively participate in the classroom program, it may be necessary to request that they go home to change their clothing.
